

The Highlights and Challenges of Bilingual Teaching May 13, 2024

Challenge: Shortage of qualified teachers

- teacher needs to be equipped with knowledge about subject and both languages
- lack of training programs or too time consuming for many teachers
- lack of confidence
- training not mandatory
- often little support or incentives given from administration
- high work load

Challenge: Finding the right bilingual material

- abundance of classroom material (-> Less is More!)
- CLIL relies on quality and suitability of materials
- challenges: problems of cultural content, outdated content, lack of authenticity
- teachers invest extra time to craft their own materials
- => impacts on job satisfaction

Challenge: The Learners

- Different home (language) environment and parenting behaviors
- Home literacy instruction => significant influence on children's attitude towards the foreign language
- different levels of proficiency of students
- students' personalities and attitudes towards CLIL
- Learners' fears and expectations

Possible solutions for educators:

- Create/join networks for bilingual teachers
- Find out what motivates you
- Encourage and support others
- Swap material and sources
- Find projects for your bilingual classes that enrich both you and your students
- Let go of high expectations
